



Beaded Wine Glass



Required Skills

Wire Wrapping:
If you haven't learned wire wrapping, we teach this skill in our class *Introduction to Wire Wrapping*. You can also find instructions in our book, *Basic Beading the Bead World Way*, or on our website www.beadworldinc.com

Required Supplies

18 gauge Craft Wire (2 ½ feet)
6mm Swarovski Cubes (4)
6mm Swarovski Bicones (6)
6mm Czech glass round beads (5)
Round nose pliers and flat nose pliers
Wire cutters

Instructions

1. Curl the end of the craft wire with your round nose pliers and then use the flat nose pliers to form a coil (as shown below left.) Bend the wire up slightly, then string on one cube, one bicone and one cube (as shown below right.)



2. Hold the coil firmly against the base of the wine glass and wrap the wire tightly around the stem of the glass three times (as shown below left). String on one round bead, one bicone and one round bead. Wrap the beaded craft wire around the stem at a slight angle, the wrap three more times around the stem (as shown below right). Repeat this pattern until you reach the top of the stem. Your second set of beads will be cube, bicone, cube. The third set will be round, bicone, round.



3. Finish by wrapping around the stem tightly several times. Bend the wire out slightly. Thread on one bicone and form the end of the wire into a loop. Cut off excess wire (as shown below left). Make a new coil with the extra wire and string on one bicone and one round bead. Form a wire wrapped loop to make a decorative dangle (as shown below center). String this dangle onto the loop on the wine stem and wrap closed. The finished glass is shown on the front page. Cheers!
