



## Celtic Heart Bracelet

### Required Supplies

Sterling silver chain (5 inches)  
Gold plated Celtic heart beads (4)  
3 inch piece of 24 gauge sterling silver wire (4)  
Sterling silver trigger clasp  
6mm 19 gauge sterling silver jump ring  
Wire cutters  
Needle nose pliers and round nose pliers



### Required Skills

Basic Wire Wrapping:

If you haven't learned basic wire wrapping, we teach this skill in our class *Introduction to Wire Wrapping*. You can also find instructions in our book, *Basic Beading the Bead World Way*, or on our website [www.beadworldinc.com](http://www.beadworldinc.com)

### Instructions

1. Cut sterling silver chain into 1 inch pieces. Form a wire loop on one end of a piece of sterling silver wire. String the end link of a piece of chain onto the wire loop (as shown below left.) Using your wire wrapping skills, wrap the loop closed. Cut off any excess wire (as shown below right).



2. Slide one Celtic heart bead into the wire, and then form another wire loop above the bead. String the end link of a second piece of chain onto the loop (as shown below left). Using your wire wrapping skills, wrap the loop closed. Cut off any excess wire (as shown below right). Continue linking pieces of chain together in this manner until all of your chain is connected. Adjust the length of your end chain sections to your desired bracelet length.



3. Open the jump ring on your trigger clasp and string on the end link of your chain (as shown below left). Carefully close the loop. Open your 6mm jump ring and pass it through the end link on the other end of your bracelet. Close the loop carefully. The finished bracelet is shown below right.
