



Swarovski Tassel Earrings

Required Skills

Basic Wire Wrapping:

If you haven't learned basic wire wrapping, we teach this skill in our class *Introduction to Wire Wrapping*. You can also find instructions in our book, *Basic Beading the Bead World Way*, or on our website www.beadworldinc.com

Required Supplies

12x8mm Swarovski Polygon 5203 (2) – we used Light Colorado Topaz Satin

1 ¾ inch length of brass chain (2)

1 ½ inch length of vintage brass chain (2)

1 ¼ inch length of brass chain (2)

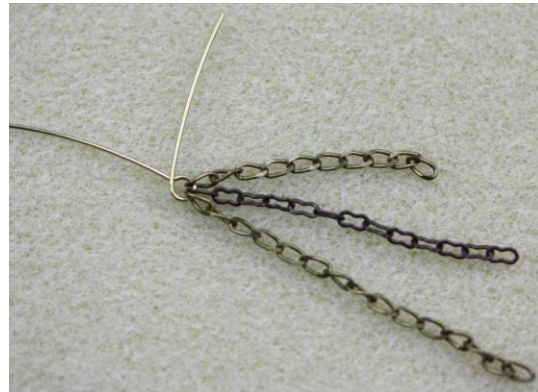
Brass ear wires (2)

3 inch piece of 22 gauge brass wire (2)

Round nose pliers, chain nose pliers, wire cutters

Instructions

1. Lay out your chain for the first earring, with one piece of each length (as shown below left.) Using your basic wire wrapping skills, form a loop on one side of the brass wire. Thread on the three chains (as shown below right.) Be sure to leave plenty of wire for a bead and second wire wrap.



2. Wrap the loop closed and cut off any excess wire (as shown below left). Thread on one Swarovski polygon bead and make another finished wire wrapped loop (as shown below right).



3. Open the loop at the bottom of the ear wire. Thread on the closed wire wrapped loop and close the ear wire loop (as shown below left). The finished earring is shown below right. Repeat all steps to make the second earring.
